## Fortinet FortiMail Earns 18th Consecutive Virus Bulletin Antispam Award

### Messaging Security Solution Earns Comparative VBSpam Certification Based on Increased Performance, High Spam Catch Rate and Zero False Positives in the Newsletter Samples Test

Virus Bulletin staff tested FortiMail along with 18 other antispam products from multiple countries for spam catch rates and false positive rates. In addition to winning its 18th consecutive award, the report noted that FortiMail had only one false positive out of 10,486 legitimate emails and zero false positives out of 201 email newsletters.

"With 99.86% of spam blocked, FortiMail had one of the higher spam catch rates and the fourth highest final score," said Martijn Grooten, anti-spam test director for Virus Bulletin.

"When considering deploying an email security solution, it's important to evaluate a vendor that's been validated by an independent, third-party test company, such as Virus Bulletin," said Patrick Bedwell, vice president of product marketing for Fortinet. "What sets FortiMail apart from its competitors are its robust performance, deployment options and its malware detection technology, which is updated by the FortiGuard global threat research team 24/7/365. This is the same, award-winning threat detection technology also found in our FortiClient, FortiGate and FortiWeb product lines."
